Established: Evangelhouse was established in 1995.

Gender: Girls only.

Ages: 6th through 12th grades.

Capacity: 20 students.

Length of Stay: 12 months or longer.

Enrollment: Year-round open admissions.

Availability: We have openings available immediately.

Philosophy: We provide licensed, behavioral healthcare in a non-denominational Christian environment.

Parent Involvement: Parents visit or call anytime but suggested structure is provided by therapeutic stages. Stages also guide weekly scheduled phone calls letters and emails.

State licensure: Louisiana Department of Education, non-public schools, alternative school division.

Behavioral Accreditation: Evangelhouse is accredited by the Joint Commission Behavioral Health Program.

Academic accreditation: ECA is approved by the Louisiana Department of Education, Non-public schools alternative school division. Additionally, academic coursework completed at ECA may be eligible for multiple accrediting bodies, depending on the students' circumstances and academic standing.

Membership: National Association of Therapeutic Schools and Programs since 2004.

Tuition: Monthly tuition is \$13,250. Call us for details about other fees, current rates and offers.

Other Fees: Admission fee, academic & enrichment fee along with alumni fee are due upon enrollment.

Application fee: None.

Financial aid: Call us for current offers.

Health Insurance: A percentage of tuition may be eligible for health insurance reimbursement. Ask for details.

Academics: Accredited college preparatory, general or vocational high school diploma options.

Staffing: The Evangelhouse treatment team is led by licensed clinicians with ministry experience. All staff have college degrees and professional credentials in addition to ministry experience.

Therapy: Three licensed Christian clinicians on staff provide seven hours per week of direct therapy and oversee the therapeutic program culture.

Psychiatrist: Adolescent specialist psychiatrist.

Medications: Psychiatric medication management services are provided.

Psychologist: Consulting outpatient neuro-psychologist.

Psychological testing: Full battery of psychological testing available.

Individual therapy: Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) and EMDR. Solution-focused, systems theory based milieu therapy.

Family therapy: Collaborate model structural therapy, strategic therapy and Christian parent coaching.

Group therapy: Positive peer culture, character development, leadership development, DBT skills group and process therapy.

Therapeutic Program: We provide a stages of change model, with emphasis on Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), social skills training and Structural Family Therapy.

Church attendance: All students attend off campus Sunday morning worship service and Thursday evening youth group meeting. Catholic families may elect an additional Tuesday evening Mass.
